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APPROACHING THE PROBLEM OF LITERARY WORK INTEGRITY

The article reveals the diversity of approaches to the problem of integrity category of a literary work at transitional epochs, and the influence of the particular type of literary consciousness which predetermines the comprehension of the integrity category. The conducted analysis of the novel *To be Bosch* by A. Korolev proved that the representation of the factors providing a literary work's integrity, set in the literary science in XX c., on the one hand, was shaped by the analysis of literary classics, and, on the other hand, doesn't conform to creative art principles which characterize the situation of XX-XXI cc., when a new paradigm of artistic value has been set.

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THE A.S. PUSHKIN'S NOVEL *EUGENE ONEGIN* IN THE ILLUMINATION OF D.I. ČYŽEVSKYJ AND V.V. NABOKOV

The article reviews the main motives of V.V. Nabokov's controversy in the Comments to *Eugene Onegin* with D.I. Čyževskij as the author of the Comments to the novel by A.S. Pushkin. Herewith, the genesis of one or another information learned by them from the works of contemporary Pushkin scholars is taken into account. Nabokov's direct indications on various types of mistakes made by Čyževskij turn into a full-fledged controversy and considering that it can be possible to clarify the commentators' specifics of conceptual approaches to such significant issues of Pushkin's studies as genesis of *Eugene Onegin* and its role in evolution of the 19th century Russian literature.

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Problematizing character's ontological status in *Travels in the Scriptorium* by Paul Auster

Abstract

The paper considers ontological aspects of Paul Auster's *Travels in the Scriptorium*, a novel which explores key underlying themes of his writing: the relationship between fiction and reality, the signified and the signifier, the author and the character. The analysis demonstrates how by playing with discourses Auster creates an intricate system of fictional worlds shaped through a particular compositional setup into a metafictional structure where the author, the narrator and the characters are constantly changing places, passing from one world into another, and which produces an illusion of reality of both the frame story and the existence of characters. Nevertheless, the emphasis on the semantic uncertainty of the narrated story indicates that the world of words belongs exclusively to the domain of the imaginary which obeys the logic of illusion.
